What is Workflowy?

Workflowy is a simple but powerful outlining tool. You can use it to make bulleted lists that can be easily searched, navigated and filtered, and you can access these lists on any web browser or mobile device. The strength of this tool lays in its simplicity and we recommend anybody who wants to bring a little more organization to their time, tasks or thoughts should give it try.

How can it help me?

Workflowy is very effective for simple things like shopping lists or planning what you need to take on holiday, but it can also help you handle much more complicated things like project planning or planning your written work.

It can play a similar role to mind-mapping: it allows you to break complex things, like ideas or projects, down into their component parts and lays them out in a simple, accessible way. It allows you to stay in control of things that might otherwise get overwhelming. Here's two examples of the most common uses you might have for this tool:

Managing Projects

The challenge of projects is often being able to see the wood for the tree, and vice-versa. Just when you think you're on top of things, something pops up that you didn't account for, or you discover that you've been moving in the wrong direction all together.

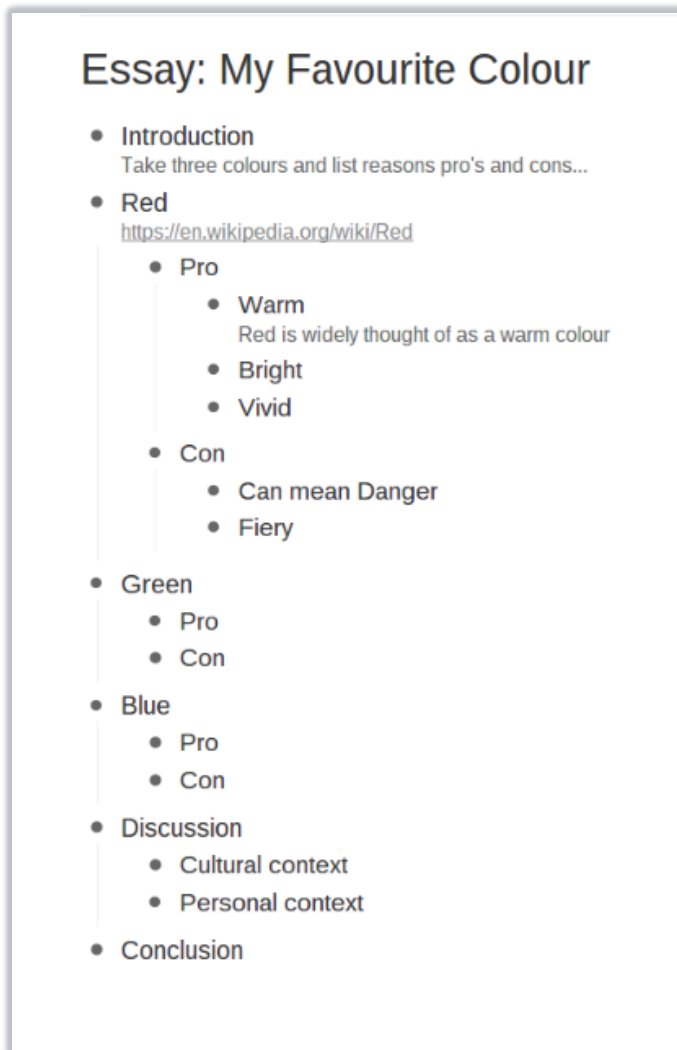
Workflowy can help break down a project into its component parts, while keeping those parts in context of the big picture.
