

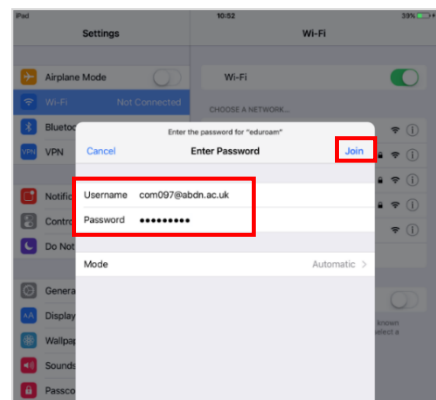
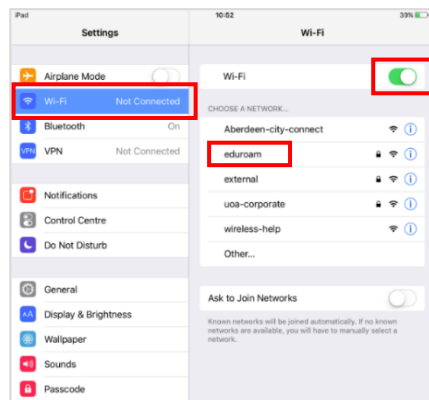
# Wireless Connection - iPad

You can use this guide to **manually** configure an iPad Wi-Fi or iPad Wi-Fi + 3G (iOS 9 or higher) to connect to the wireless service eduroam.

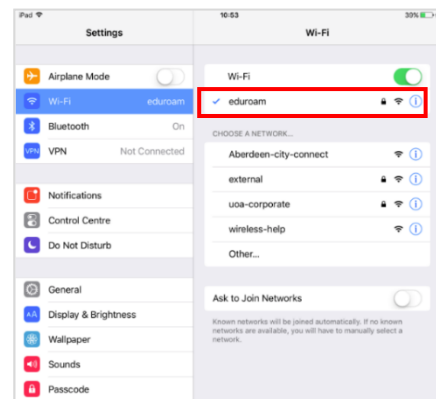
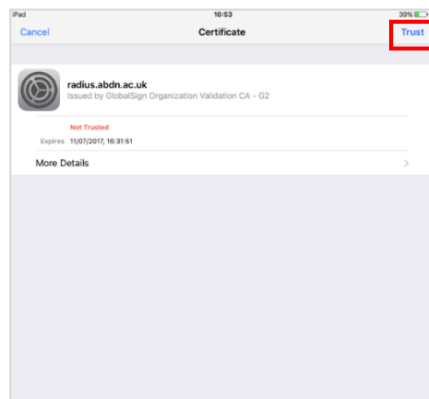


An [automatic configuration tool](#) SecureW2 is available online, try this first!<sup>1</sup>

1. Tap **Settings**
2. Tap **Wi-Fi**
3. Ensure Wi-Fi is **ON**
4. Tap **eduroam**
5. Type in *your* university **username@abdn.ac.uk** (e.g. u99jb19@abdn.ac.uk) and password and Tap **Join**



6. When the Certificate prompt is displayed, ensure that it states “radius.abdn.ac.uk” & tap **Trust**
7. When connected, a tick ✓ appears next to eduroam
8. Return to the **Home** screen

<sup>1</sup> Note: In later iOS versions, a profile is created for Wireless connections added using SecureW2. To remove a profile, go to **Settings – General – Profile** or **Settings– General – VPN & Device Management**. Select the profile that is no longer needed or is no longer working due to a password change and choose Remove Profile.
