Duration: 12 months full-time or 24 months part-time (MLitt)

Content: Candidates undertake the following:

FULL TIME ROUTE

Compulsory courses:

- PD5006 Getting Started at the University of Aberdeen (0 credit points)
- AH501A Art and Christianity (30 credit points)
- AH501D Materialising Faith: Women, Art and Religion, 1150-1500 (30 credit points)
- AH551F Romantic Revivals: Religion in 19th-Century Art (30 credit points)
- AH551G Theology and Aesthetics (30 credit points)
- AH5501 Christianity and the Visual Arts Dissertation Preparation (0 credit points)

Candidates for the MLitt must additionally take:

- AH591A Christianity and the Visual Arts Dissertation (60 credit points)

Assessment: Courses will be assessed by course work, by examination or by a combination of these, as prescribed for each course. The degree of MLitt shall not be awarded to candidates who fail to achieve a CGS grade of D3 or above in the dissertation, irrespective of their performance in other courses.

First Year:

Second Year

One elective in each sub-session to be chosen from:
