2.	<u>MS 3553 Research Methods for Business</u> is normally a prescribed course for students who intend to take their dissertation in Business Management. However, the Business Management Teaching & Learning Convenor has approved <u>PI 3066 Political Research in the 21st Century</u> as an equivalent research methods course, which will be accepted as a pre-requisite for the Dissertation in Business Management. Students on this degree programme are not required to take MS 3553.
