Duration: 36 months part time study.

Content: The programme consists of a pathway of courses carrying 30 or 60 credit points at SCQF Level 11 (PG5). Participants who successfully complete 60 credit points may leave with a Certificate, those who successfully complete 120 credit points may leave with a Diploma and the MEd will be awarded on successful completion of 180 credit points.

In addition, each course contains elements of formative assessment which serves to support learning and provide evidence of individual achievement.
