2.	Candidates who have not passed PS 4019 but have enough other elements in the Grade Spectrum for the award of an Honours degree shall be awarded the non-accredited Behavioural Studies degree.
3.	Honours programme may only be taken by full-time study.
4.	Designated Degree:  A minimum of 360 credit points including 120 credit points from Psychology at level 1 and 2 and 90 credit points from the following courses: Level 3 PS 3011, PS 3012, PS 3014, PS 3518, PS 3519, PS 3520.
