## **PART TIME ROUTE**

Students will take a total of 180 course credits over two years

### **Year 1**

PD50C2 Critical Skills: Reading and Engagement (0 credit points) must be taken in Year 1

EL50D2 Fundamentals of English Language (30 credits)

### **Year 2**

Students are required to select 60 credits from available EL coded Level 5 courses plus the dissertation.
