

CHRISTIANITY AND THE VISUAL ARTS (MLitt/PgDip/PgCert) 56V62SA2/61V62SVX/62V62SVZ

Duration: 12 months full-time or 24 months part-time (MLitt)

Content: Candidates undertake the following:

FULL TIME ROUTE

Compulsory courses:

PD5006 Getting Started at the University of Aberdeen (0 credit points)
AH501B Art and Christianity (30 credit points)
AH501E Researching Art and Faith (15 credit points)
AH551H Theology and Aesthetics (30 credit points)
AH551C Displaying Faith (15 credits)

Plus 30 credit points from the following options:

LT1009 Latin 1 (15 credit points)
LT1507 Latin 2 (15 credit points)
HI501D Palaeography – (15 credit points)
HI552L Approaching Archives – (15 credit points)

Students may, at the discretion of the course and programme coordinators, substitute up to 30 credit points from the above courses with other courses offered within the University, including other Level 5 courses in the School of Divinity, History, Philosophy and Art History as well as in other schools.

Candidates for the MLitt must additionally take:

AH591B Christianity and the Visual Arts Dissertation (60 credit points)

Assessment: Courses will be assessed by course work, by examination or by a combination of these, as prescribed for each course. The degree of MLitt shall not be awarded to candidates who fail to achieve a CGS grade of D3 or above in the dissertation, irrespective of their performance in other courses.

PART TIME ROUTE

This route will run over two years. Students will take a maximum of 180 credit points over the two years. Courses taken in Year 1 cannot be taken again in Year 2.

Year 1:

PD5006 Getting Started at the University of Aberdeen (0 credit points)
AH501B Art and Christianity (30 credit points) – 1st sub-session
AH551H Theology and Aesthetics (30 credit points) – 2nd sub-session
AH5902 Christianity and the Visual Arts Dissertation Preparation (0 credit points) – 3rd sub-session

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Year 2:

AH501E Researching Art and Faith (15 credit points) – 1st sub-session

AH551C Displaying Faith (15 credits) – 2nd sub-session

AH591B Christianity and the Visual Arts Dissertation 2 (60 credits) – 3rd sub-session

Two training courses must be taken from the following list during the two-year programme, amounting to 30 credit points in total.

LT1009 Latin 1 (15 credit points)

LT1507 Latin 2 (15 credit points)

HI501D Palaeography – (15 credit points)

HI552L Approaching Archives – (15 credit points)
