PS5539 A Psychology Toolkit for Consulting (15 credit points)

Stage 3

All of the courses for Stage 1 and Stage 2, plus

BU593F The Consulting Challenge (60 credit points)
OR
BU593E Business Consulting Dissertation (60 credit points)

Assessment:

By course work, group work, presentations, written examination or by a combination of those, as prescribed for each course. The degree of MSc shall not be awarded to a candidate who fails to achieve a CGS Grade D3 in the relevant final stage course irrespective of their performance in other courses.
