Content: Candidates shall be required to attend the following designated programme of courses:

Year 1

- EG5548 Project Planning and Control (15 credit points)
- EG5576 Delivering Successful Projects (15 credit points)
- EG595B Commercial and Contractual Issues (15 credit points)
- EG595C Budgets and Financial Control (15 credit points)
- EG5049 Organisations and People (15 credit points)
- EG5077 Project Management (15 credit points)

Year 2

- EG5551 Group Project in Project Management (15 credit points)
- EG5564 Quality Systems and Risk Management (15 credit points)

(MSc candidates only)

- EG5954 Individual Project in Project Management (30 credit points)

- EG5052 Managing Project Teams (15 credit points)
- EG50P5 Portfolio Project Management (15 credit points)

Assessment: By a combination of written examination and course work as prescribed for each course. In addition, MSc candidates must submit a dissertation on their individual project and may be required to undergo an oral examination.

The degree of MSc shall not be awarded to a candidate who fails to achieve a CGS Grade of D3 or above in the individual project, irrespective of their performance in other courses.
