Aim: Fast track conversion programme(s) for graduates seeking entry to the chartered surveying profession. The Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (RICS) accredits both the Postgraduate Diploma (pgDip) and the Master (MLE). The purpose of the programme(s) is to prepare candidates for entry to the Rural or the Environmental Faculty of RICS.

Duration:

Accredited options: 12 months full time (MLE, 180 credits); 12 months full time (PgDip, 180 credits); 24 months part time (MLE or PgDip, 180 credits).

Non-accredited options: 9 months full time (PgCert, 60 credits, no Dissertation or Diploma Case Study); or 12 months full time or 24 months part time (PgDip, 120 credits, no Dissertation or Diploma Case Study).
