Stage 2

Stage 3

- QA50C1 Communication Theory and Analysis (30 credit points)
- QB5045 Negotiation and Cross-Cultural Management (15 credit points)
- QB5054 Marketing Management (15 credit points)

PART TIME ROUTE

This route will run over two years.

- QQ5501 Getting Started at the University of Aberdeen (0 credit points) – must be taken in Year 1
- QA55C2 Intercultural Communication (15 credit points)
- QA55C3 Institutional Discourse (30 credit points)
- QB5553 The Leadership Challenge (15 credit points)
- QA59C4 Dissertation in Professional Communication (60 credit points) – must be taken in Year 2
- QA50C1 Communication Theory and Analysis (30 credit points)
- QB5045 Negotiation and Cross-Cultural Management (15 credit points)
- QB5054 Marketing Management (15 credit points)
