

HEALTH DATA SCIENCE (ONLINE – SEPTEMBER START) (MSc/PgDip/PgCert)

It takes a minimum of 24 months to complete the MSc programme. There are four compulsory courses for the award of MSc, but all courses can be enrolled on in any order. Students are recommended to enrol on PU5058 as early as possible.

Notes

- Students can elect not to enrol on any Term 3 courses and instead complete their degree by enrolling solely on Term 1 and Term 2 courses.
- Students can elect to enrol on only one of PU5919 or PU5923 and achieve the remaining credits for their award by enrolling on Term 1 and Term 2 courses, or they can study both PU5919 or PU5923.
- Students cannot enrol on both PU5922 and PU5927.
- Students cannot enrol on both PU5923 and PU5927.
- PU5922 and PU5927 are not available as part of the PGCert or PGDip - they can only be enrolled on by students studying towards the award of MSc.
- PU5922, PU5923, and PU5927 can only be enrolled on following the completion of 120 credits. PU5919 can be enrolled on earlier (e.g. during Term 3 of Year 1).
